

TwoWheel - 8 day packing List...

Packing light is way more fun that you would think...? And of course this means for the shopaholics you may have to buy a few goodies/shirts while you are travelling. ☺ We visit some great bike shops along the way and Nashville is a fantastic place on the way home to grab all your souvenirs.

Most places we stay on the tour will have a laundry, so you can always do a quick load if you need to. Two wheel Tours are conducted during the warmer months of spring and summer; but some of the tour are through higher elevations and can be cool. So it's great to be packed for all weather conditions.

Here is a basic list of things we advise. If you are extending your trip and staying on to travel some of the other wonderful parts of the USA then pack more. Other luggage for your extended trip can be left at the rental company, but if you're just doing the Two Wheel tour then we would suggest that your luggage stays under 7kg.

Remember you either have to carry it on you or on the bike, so the lighter the better.

- Helmet – *the hire company only supplies open face helmets so if you would prefer to bring your own then please do... just make sure it's in a secured bag to protect it while it's on the plane. You can find a great fox one similar to this on Ebay. Or we can order one for you from our suppliers. Please order this at least 2 weeks prior to departure.*

- Gloves
- Light Rain Suit – if you have one
- Riding or Leather Jacket – *this can be worn on the plane*
- 1 x Long sleeve T-Shirt
- 2 x Short Sleeve T-Shirts
- Underwear
- Socks
- Togs
- Thongs - *for after the ride*
- Riding Boots
- 3 x Jeans or riding leathers
- 1 x Shorts
- Vest – if you'd prefer for hotter weather
- Bandanas/scarf
- PJ's
- Small Sun Screen
- Medications – *visit your doctor prior to departure to get letter for travelling and supplies for period needed away.*
- Toiletries as needed- *All liquids needs to be under 100ml for USA travelling laws and no aerosols for hand luggage*
- American Wall charger connector
- Camera/Go-Pro - *plenty of memory cards*
- Or make sure your phone is backed up and storage is free as this is easy way of snapping shots while on the go.

The Tendency is to always pack too much. Packing different clothes that can be worn in layers when it gets cold is a much better idea, and then you can remove layers as the temperature rises.
